Tasting Notes:

This Red Wine is very approachable as it offers up very soft and silky tannins, with a long, clean finish. On the nose you get dark cherry, blackberry and hints of earth and spice. Upon entry, there's a glorious, natural fruit sweetness that resembles dark, robust berries. A long, lingering finish with measured oak flavors make this a great food-pairing wine. Pairs perfectly with light Italian dishes and tomato- based sauces – chicken, fish, pork & marinara based pastas.

Vineyard Notes:

This wine hails from the Paso Robles AVA in California's famed Central Coast. This AVA was once the prime growing region for California Zinfandel but in the 1960's, growers realized that this region could grow world class Cabernet and other Bordeaux varietals. Paso Robles offers a greater day-to-night temperature swing than any other appellation in California. It also boasts many distinct microclimates, diverse soils and a long growing season. All of these combined create a world-class growing region.

Winemaker Notes:

This wine was crafted with the old world in mind. Made with a similar blend to a classic Bordeaux, this wine is very European in style - elegant, soft and approachable. This wine spent 14 months in French Oak, 30% of which was new. Comprised of 65% Cabernet Sauvignon, 17% Cabernet Franc, 6% Malbec, 7% Petit Verdot, 5% Merlot.
