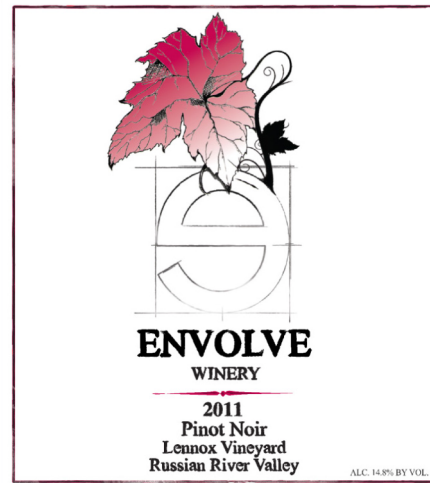


2011 Envolve Lennox Vineyard Pinot Noir

Tasting Notes:

With aromatics of cola and bright red cherries, a dash of spice and cedar, this Russian River Pinot Noir is elegant and complete. Perfectly integrated tannins balance the notes of red plum, black cherry and blueberry on the finish.

Vineyard Notes:

Our sustainably farmed 2011 Lennox Vineyard Pinot Noir comes from a family owned, nine-acre vineyard located on the southern edge of the Russian River Valley appellation. The Pinot Noir clones are (Dijon 115, 667 & 777 on 101-14 rootstock).

Winemaker Notes:

Our 2011 Pinot was picked in the early morning to retain good acidity and keep the fruit bright. This wine was de-stemmed and whole berry fermented in stainless steel tanks. A four-day cold soak on this wine was used to add color and texture to this beautiful Pinot as well as three pump overs a day to allow for more extraction, flavor and color. Once fermentation was finished, we drained the free run juice and pressed the skins into barrels. This wine was aged in the caves for 10 months in 100% French Oak and 35% New.

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
